LOMANDRA

Mat Rush

Originating from Australia, these evergreen plants are known for their robust, grass-like foliage and adaptability to various environmental conditions. With an ability to thrive in diverse soils and climates, making Lomandra a low-maintenance choice for landscaping. Its slender, strap-shaped foliage create a distinctive visual appeal. Their resilience to drought conditions makes them particularly valuable in water-wise landscaping.



LIRIOPE STRAPPY FOR SHADE



Foliage & Growth: Liriope typically have linear, arching leaves arising from a central clump. The foliage is evergreen, providing visual interest throughout the year. The leaves can range in colour from green to variegated varieties.

Flowers: Lirope produces spikes or racemes of small, tubular flowers. The flowering period varies by species and cultivar, generally occurring in late summer or early fall. Common flower colours include shades of purple, violet, lavender, and white.

Adaptability: Well-suited for a range of environmental conditions. It thrives in well-drained soil but can tolerate a variety of soil types. Additionally, these plants are adaptable to both full sun and partial shade, making them a versatile choice for different garden settings.

Landscaping Uses: Liriope is often used as a ground cover, edging, or border plant due to their clumping growth habit. They can also be planted beneath trees or in shaded areas where other plants may struggle.

Low Maintenance: One of the key attractions of Liriope is its low-maintenance nature. Once established, these plants are relatively drought-tolerant and require minimal care, Pruning is generally only necessary to remove spent flower spikes or to control the spread in certain settings.



AGAPANTHUS

African Lily

Available in a range of cultivars, Agapanthus varieties exhibit various flower colours, including shades of blue, violet, and white. Climbers



Trachelospermum Jasminoides is a robust climber with glossy leaves and highly fragrant white flowers blooming continuously from Summer to Autumn. Versatile, it covers structures, serves as ground cover, a low hedge, or a container plant. Thriving in full sun to part shade and various soils, it's low-maintenance, drought-tolerant, reaching 3-6 meters as a climber or maintaining 30-40cm height as ground cover.

MANDEVILLA

A genus of tropical and subtropical flowering vines and shrubs known for their stunning, trumpet-shaped flowers. Mandevillas typically feature glossy green leaves and produce large, showy blooms in various shades, including pink, red, and white, popular choices for adding vibrant colours to gardens and landscapes. They thrive in warm climates and can be grown both as climbers or container plants, making them versatile options for gardens, patios, and balconies. With proper care they can provide spectacular display of blossoms throughout the growing season, adding a touch of tropical beauty to outdoor spaces.





SCREENING SYZYGIUM


Lilly Pilly






SUMMER FOLIAGE COLOUR

GOLDEN CANE

DYPSIS LUTESCENS

Evergreen / Outdoor / Palm/ Cycad / Perennial Dimensions: 1m high x 1m wide

Dypsis lutescens, a resilient tropical palm, is prized for its decorative appeal. Sporting numerous golden-colored trunks, it lacks a central trunk and gracefully curves outward from the base. This versatile palm serves well in landscaping and as an indoor plant, adding charm to areas around pools, patios, and as an ideal tub specimen. Whether placed indoors in a warm spot with filtered light or outdoors in a sunny to partly shaded, frost-free position, Dypsis lutescens adapts. For optimal growth, it benefits from regular fertilization during the warmer months.



KENTIA PALM

HOWEA FORSTERIANA

Evergreen / Indoor/Shade / Native Australian Plant / Outdoor / Palm/Cycad / Perennial / Tree Dimensions: 9m high x 4m wide

The Kentia Palm, native to Lord Howe Island off the east coast, is characterized by its relatively slow growth, featuring a slender trunk and gracefully drooping fronds. Howea forsteriana has been a favored indoor plant since the Victorian era and continues to be popular today. Adaptable to low sunlight, air conditioning, and central indoor heating, Howea forsteriana is known for its low maintenance requirements. When kept indoors, it thrives in areas with decent but indirect sunlight exposure, and it is crucial not to overwater.



BAMBOO

BAMBUSA GRACILIS

Gracilis bamboo, originating from China, is a compact and attractive variety known for its straight, slender form and lush green foliage. Ideal for container planting and offers a classic bamboo look, reaching up to 6 meters in just two years, making it excellent for space-efficient landscaping and screening against noise and lights. Adaptable to containment in a 50cm-wide area, it is the most popular bamboo variety in Australia, thriving year-round with frequent watering initially and minimal maintenance once established.












FERNS

PHLEBODIUM DAVANA

Phlebodium Davana, an exquisite and compact fern with deeply lobed fronds, thrives in well-draining soil when placed in shaded areas of rock gardens, borders, or as indoor potted plants. Ensure soil moisture during dry periods and apply a slow-release fertilizer in spring. For optimal growth, use a diluted liquid fertilizer every four weeks in warmer months, taking care to avoid over-concentration. This fern, reaching heights of 60-90cm and widths of 30-40cm, should be protected from frost to maintain its vitality.



- Veggies Fairy Veggies (80 cell trays); Garden Fresh (80 cell trays and Maxi Pots), including Tomatoes, Chillies, Eggplants and more; and Garden Fresh Advanced (4 packs) including Herb Mix, Lettuce Mix and more.
- Strawberries (Maxi Pots).
- The Diggers Club (80 cell trays, 4 packs, and Maxi Pots) heirloom varieties, including Beetroots, Rainbow Chard and more.

We are dedicated to restoring our natural environment, prompting the establishment of a specialized native revegetation division. Armed with expertise, we excel in cultivating premium native tube stock for landscaping and revegetation ventures. Our offerings cater to diverse environments, such as coastal areas, wetlands, riverbanks, coastal plain woodlands, Perth hills, post-harvest rehabilitation in pine forests, and reclaimed farmland, spanning both urban and regional locales. To continue to advance and develop growing of the finest quality best value plants, the ability to innovate is critical. Through consultation and collaboration with key staff, industry specialists and calling on the wealth of knowledge and experience from senior generations, we continue to improve our efficiency and systems to ensure the most suitable plants are supplied. Some of these methods include:

- Mass produce reeds and sedges or hand produce more delicate species.
- All stock produced is air pruned providing a far higher survival rate for revegetation projects.
